Rachel Obenchain-Had some folks from the community come in to talk to her class about business.

Duane Barnhart-CVHS just got a \$22,000 grant. They are also going to have a career fair in February sometime. He was not sure of the date.

Maureen Parker-University High School just had a career panel for students to be able to listen to what different people did at work. They talked to over 400 students during a 2 hour window at U-High. Mostly 10-12th graders

- b. Event on SFCC's campus

Debbie was thinking about having some speed networking to meet with students and put into smaller groups. The lunch time would be on your own then having some students going to businesses for some of the students. Schools are encouraged to gather small groups of interested kids and van them over to SFCC for the day. Debbie is still working on the logistics of how it will all work and will get that out as soon as it is final. Tom asked if March 14th would work and people agreed as long as it doesn't conflict with testing window.

ii. NIC for younger students

Looking at possibly using NIC for another Career day with younger students, not seniors, to do a career day at NIC, Tom suggested that NIC could be a good spot for students to land because SFCC has long waiting lists for some degrees. Rob talked about SFCC having the new destination for Photography schooling because Brooks school is closing which makes SFCC's program one of just a few left. Date for NIC will be talked about at a later meetin

NEW BUSINESS

a. WSOS Scholarship <https://www.waopportunityscholarship.org/>

STEM based scholarship if students take the time to apply lots of students get the financial aid or scholarship. It can be up to \$22,000 for 4 years. Terri Ashby-Scott will come around and help you if you need help with the process. Opens in January and they have some sample applications for you to look at on the website.

b. Teachers visiting each other—events

Debbie talked about some engineering students going down to the middle school and talking with girls about engineering degrees. Rob talked about visiting other teachers in Yakima and sharing ideas and it was very helpful. Rick said we should talk about what we are doing in our classrooms with businesses and get their ideas on maybe different ways we can teach and talk about things. Duane suggested we meet next time at one of the schools so we can see what the students and teachers are doing. Tom suggested we could have businesses come in and help with classroom projects. Tom liked the idea of meeting next time in a school and opened it up to volunteers. We are still waiting to hear back from a school that would like to host the next meeting.

Rob suggested we need to do something about our funding at the state level before CTE is no longer able to run on its current funding schedule. MJ Bolt suggested we talk to our legislators and assured us the group from the state is working on that now.

- c. SFCC and their Bachelor of Applied Science in Information Systems and Information Technology

SFCC is now offering a 3 year degree for a BA in Applied Science and IT. Butch is going to meet with a student currently enrolled in the program to see how it is working out.
