READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes from the February 22, 2017 HSAC meeting were reviewed and approved by the committee.

OLD BUSINESS

Lori Buratto and Joe McCollum filled us in about SVT and University High School’s participation in the new Eastern Washington Regional Science and Engineering Fair. They reported many changes in the registration process and format of the event and report that there is a lot of potential for this to become a quality event for our health sciences students.

Eric Jurasin of Spokane Valley High School shared that his students were able to attend the Business After School Chas Clinic Tour. He reports that it was a meaningful experience for his Biomed students

Lori Buratto shared some of the Business and Industry Members in the Classroom opportunities that they have at SVT. An ER Design presentation is scheduled for May, they have had a practitioner who works with students with cerebral palsy share some of his practices and the technology he uses for patient therapy.

Matt Albright reviewed some of the committee accomplishments of the year including approval of the Environmental Engineering framework, development of the Prezi tool for career connected learning, connecting students to local job opportunities, a tour of the Spokane Teaching Health Center, and new Business and Industry Members.

NEW BUSINESS

Krystal Poland from Spokane Regional Health District introduced herself and her role at SRHD as an HIV/ADIS patient case worker. She works to provide support and resources for full care with emphasis on aspects of life besides the clinical aspects of HIV care. She shared that her educational background is in Public Health and that others in her field may have a Masters in Public Health or a Masters in Social Work.

We discussed new goals for the 2017-2018 school year. These include continuing to bring Business and Industry members into the classroom and to continue to have Business and Industry Members presenting the top-5 in-demand careers to teachers at advisory committee meetings.

Next year we would like to continue development o the Prezi Presentation for career connected learning with Business and Industry Member feedback. We would also like to complete the edited Free Standing Emergency Department video for use in the 3rd year Biomed curriculum.

Next year’s agenda also includes follow-up with Dr. Judy Benson from the Spokane Teaching Health Clinic to create a code simulation experience at Sacred Heart Medical Center for our students. We would also like to work on developing this year’s ER tour at SHMC into a dedicated annual event.

We also put partnering with the local community colleges (SCC/SFCC/NIC), bringing members from these organizations into the Advisory Committee. We would like to partner with them to create events for students (tours of facilities, programs, and perhaps a birth simulation at NIC).

Committee members also suggested some additions to next year's agenda. Brandy Tarala of AMR shared that embalming is an in-demand, well-paying career that we may want to incorporate in our community.

Phil Plesek suggested that we pursue follow-up on tracking student outcomes in the biomedical sciences programs. Vicki Leifer suggested that we look into a consortium between the valley schools working with GAC on this.

Vicki suggested we also discuss using career cruising data (West Valley and Central Valley Districts have this program) to find students who may be interested in Health Sciences events.

Lori Buratto shared that 8 4th-year Biomed students at the SVT will be partnered with Providence for a 1-year Medical Assistant Program in which students receive pay and full-benefits during training and loan-forgiveness if they work for Providence.

Break-out Sessions: Business and Industry Members joined Eric Jurasin to give feedback to the Prezi tool and develop it further with a new patient scenario involving imaging, orthopedic surgical technicians, and other locally relevant health sciences careers. Teachers joined Brandy Tarala from AMR. She presented information about dispatching, EMT-Basic, and Paramedic job, required training, and local opportunities and hosted a question and answer session about these careers for teachers.
