## READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Meeting minutes from March 15, 2018. Approved as submitted. Tom was not at the meeting so Paul May, General Advisory Chair, signed the meeting minutes.

## REPORTS

Lucus Hansen joined us today for our meeting. He graduated from CVHS and is now attending NIC. He got a job in Iowa and talked about his experience leaving CV with skills and a vision of what he wanted to do. Lucas went straight from high school to NIC and then accepted a job using skills he learned in Alan Wardsworth's class that carried into his NIC work.

Paul gave an update on the keyboarding and basic computer skills survey that went out to the schools. All of the districts except West Valley have turned their survey in and Paul said it will be reported at the General Advisory Meeting in May. He thanked this group for bringing it up and said it is an important subject.

## NEW BUSINESS

KayCee Murray has agreed to be the new Business Chairperson for the CIT committee. KayCee will help with the planning for next year and take over for the 2018-2019 school year. Tom has stepped down and will be a member of the committee. We appreciate everything Tom has done to help this committee and the effort to help build a bridge between business and education.

We took a tour of the Central Valley High School CTE classrooms. Alan showed us his photo class and explained what programs they use. Then we were able to see the studio (green room) and space used for music/sound. Alan talked about the class and the cameras that work best for him are the Cannon Cameras.

Kyle had five students that showed us the work they are doing in the Graphic Design 2 class. They talked about the Graphic Design class and how it helps them with skills they can use in the workplace. Careers were mentioned and each student talked a little about their strengths in Graphic Design. They talked about their work with the Wacom Tablet <https://www.wacom.com/en-us> in this class and in their artwork. These students did an great job of explaining their work and answering questions.

Butch has students getting all the Microsoft Certifications and has a junior going to work at Chas at this time. East Valley is having a class after school to help get student certifications.

We talked about articulation agreements and that CVSD and EVSD are doing them but not sure how many of the students are using the college credits. Phillippe said it is done differently in Idaho and that they are directly aligned with the NIC curriculum.

Mike asked if there are any schools (districts) that require more than 1 CTE credit? We will look into what other areas are doing to promote more CTE courses in computer science and graphic design.

Debbie bought some information from the Workforce Development Council. We discussed the information and how some of the skills are more soft skills then technical skills. Also, students knowing how to use Microsoft products will make them more valuable in the work environment.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS-**

Goals from last year and goals for next year were discussed. We met most of the goals from last year with new business members involved, visited KHQ and Numerica and had meaningful meetings. We had meetings at CVHS and Spokane Country Library and hope to get to UHigh and EV next year. A do still have the goal to get out to SFCC and NIC next fall.

Mike brought up an idea of having a communities in the school (they had a successful event this year)—students paired with professionals to show them a program/lesson. University High School would be a good location for something like this and it would be a great way to get businesses to see what our students are doing.
